

Rules for Troop 290

1. All Scouts and Adults will follow the Scout Oath and Law
2. Scouts and adult leaders will wear Class A (official) Boy Scout uniform shirts, pants, and belt at all troop meetings, and when traveling to or from campouts. 2nd class uniforms will be allowed during times designated by the PLC.
3. Scouts shall address adults as “Mr.” or “Mrs.” Leaders are encouraged to address each other in the same manner when in the presence of Scouts.
4. The troop will follow the Patrol Method and chain of command.
5. Troop meetings will start with the Pledge of Allegiance, Scout Oath & Law, and the Lord’s Prayer.
6. Scouts will treat one another with respect. They will observe the Scout Oath & Law at all times.
7. The adult leadership as appropriate will address behavior issues that cannot be resolved by the Patrol Method. The Scoutmaster has the final word on handling of discipline. Continuing discipline matters may be handled as follows:
 - a) A scout will only be allowed to attend meetings and scouting events while accompanied by a parent or guardian.
 - b) A scout will be suspended from the troop until he can demonstrate to the Scoutmaster that he can observe the Scout Oath and Law at all times.
 - c) A scout will be asked to permanently leave the troop when discipline problems continue after returning from suspension.
8. Scouts will participate in planning and execution of meetings, campouts, and high adventure events.
9. Scouts will maintain a neat appearance and not use foul language at all scouting events.
